

Removing Adhesive From the Pole



THIS IS A SIMPLE PROCESS, AND YOU ONLY NEED FOUR (4) ITEMS TO GET STARTED:

- ACETONE
- A PAIR OF PROTECTIVE GLOVES
- EYE PROTECTION
- RAGS



IN A WELL-VENTILATED AREA REMOVE THE OLD GRIP TAPE, AND ANY TAPE UTILIZED TO PROTECT THE POLE FROM THE PLANTING BOX.** ONCE THIS TAPE HAS BEEN REMOVED, YOU CAN PUT ON THE PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR AND THE RUBBER GLOVES.

****WE RECOMMEND THAT THE TAPE BE REMOVED VERY SLOWLY AND PULLED OFF AT A 90° ANGLE FROM THE POLE. THIS WILL AID IN THE TAPE REMOVAL. IF YOU PULL THE TAPE OFF QUICKLY, IT WILL RESULT IN A LOT OF ADHESIVE BEING LEFT ON THE POLE, THUS MAKING CLEAN UP HARDER AND A PAIN IN THE A##!**

OPEN THE ACETONE CONTAINER, RETRIEVE A RAG, THEN PARTIALLY SOAK THE RAG IN SEVERAL AREAS BY COVERING THE OPENING OF THE ACETONE CONTAINER AND TURNING IT UPSIDE DOWN SEVERAL TIMES. MAKE SURE TO MOVE THE RAG EACH TIME.

BEGIN TO RUB THE ACETONE-SOAKED AREAS OF THE RAG OVER ANY ADHESIVE THAT IS VISIBLE IN THE GRIPPING AREA. SOME ADHESIVES CAN BE STUBBORN AND MAY TAKE A LITTLE 'ELBOW GREASE' TO REMOVE. YOU MAY HAVE TO SOAK THE RAG SEVERAL TIMES, DEPENDING ON THE AMOUNT, AND TYPE, OF ADHESIVE LEFT BEHIND.

ONCE THE ADHESIVE IS REMOVED, GO OVER THE CLEANED AREA WITH A DRY RAG.

THE SAME PROCESS SHOULD BE UTILIZED FOR THE BOTTOM OF THE POLE.

DO NOT USE A HEAT GUN OR HAIR DRYER TO "HEAT" THE ADHESIVE. THIS MAY DAMAGE THE POLE.
